Act as the West Yorkshire Launchpad engagement and delivery manager - reporting into both Health Innovation Network Yorkshire and Humber and West Yorkshire Combined Authority (WYCA)

Innovate UK's Launchpad programme is aimed at supporting clusters of small and medium sized enterprises (SMEs) and the most innovative businesses to progress their ideas toward commercialisation, contributing to local economic growth. Each Launchpad has been developed in collaboration with local leadership, to strengthen innovation in targeted clusters across the UK. Each Launchpad cluster benefits from various forms of support such as funding for research and development, opportunities for networking and collaboration, and access to innovation specialists including Research and Technology Organisations (RTOs).

Based in West Yorkshire, this Launchpad is dedicated to pioneering breakthroughs in technologies that will improve healthcare outcomes. Innovate UK is partnering on this Launchpad with the West Yorkshire Combined Authority.

This project seeks to support health tech entrepreneurs and businesses in West Yorkshire through engagement and value-adding activities, whilst acting as ambassadors for the region's innovation and health tech cluster maximising long-term legacy and impact.

You will

- Consolidate, curate and promote existing support for SMEs and innovators, e.g., our Propel@YH Digital Health accelerator, innovator offers from key stakeholders Medilink, Medipex, the Innovate UK 'family', NHS Innovation pop-ups.
- Host events and engagement workshops for both SMEs, innovators and cluster stakeholders to promote West Yorkshire to local, national and internal businesses and investors and support B2B opportunities.





- Work to produce a dynamic innovator offer resource which signposts relevant regional support for SMEs.
- Build upon our existing funding bulletin for SMEs to produce a transparent and accessible resource for innovators seeking funding and investment.
- Amplify existing and planned activity relevant to the sector such as Leeds Digital Festival - maximising reach and impact.
- Continue to provide expert advice and guidance to individual SMEs via our commercial team, funded via Office of Life Sciences and NHS England
- Support SMEs and entrepreneurs to develop their innovations and work with the research community to get the evidence that's needed to prove whether or not an innovation works.
- Be supporting delivery of project to introduce innovative practices, products and services into health and care organisations to make a difference to patients and staff.
- Be engaging regularly with clinicians, academics, industry representatives.
- Horizon scan a pipeline of West Yorkshire HealthTech for potential national scale and export, and socialise these companies with senior NHS decision makers.
- Produce a suite of launchpad case studies, end of project impact report and legacy plan.
- Commit to ensuring the legacy and sustainability of the launchpad cluster post-2026 - working with WYCA and key stakeholders including NHS partners and industry to strengthen and embed the cluster leadership network and horizon scan a growth trajectory across a variety of indicators including investment, place maturity and job creation.
- Spend some of your week working embedded in the West Yorkshire Innovation Hub – supporting the Director with HealthTech innovation projects.

Key Duties and Responsibilities

- Build relationships throughout Health Innovation Yorkshire and Humber, West Yorkshire HealthTech Cluster, and our key partners to enable the proactive development and delivery of communications and engagement activity.
- Work closely with senior officers and other clinical colleagues, academics and managers to scope, design, develop and deliver key projects.
- Lead projects as directed by the Workstream Leads, Head of Portfolio and the Executive team.
- Support and advise innovators who are developing healthcare technologies to appropriate support for clinical validation, user testing, intellectual property advice etc.
- Support and advise SMEs with market ready innovations who are aiming to access NHS markets.
- Support the development of detailed documents, plans and resource allocations for projects.
- Produce regular and detailed performance reports against agreed metrics and KPIs for all projects.
- Design and organise conferences and facilitate workshops in support of projects being managed.
- Maintain all project documentation ready for review and audit.
- Provide a central resource for information about projects including communications, updates, documentation, progress, and actions.
- Support communications, liaising with the Marketing and Communications Team as necessary.
- Send out communications to the team to update everyone on the progress of projects and any issues people need to be aware of.

- Actively work as a team member, contributing to initiatives that aim to improve the effectiveness of the team and organisation.
